



Golf and Fishing Tournament Rules and Format

Each team will be comprised of 4 people and a Caddy Captain.

Each person will play 9 holes of golf and fish in two lakes.

Golf will be Shamble format and follow Modified Stableford scoring to earn points.

- o Each player tees off, selects the best drive, plays one net best ball until hole is complete.

Fishing points will be awarded for every fish caught based on species and weight

- o Fishing equipment will be provided at each hole
- o Volunteers will be stationed at each fishing hole to assist with baiting and weighing and releasing fish.
- o Participants can choose from a variety of live and artificial baits
- o Each group has 12 minutes to fish once lines are in the water
- o Caddy Captains will log fishing points

Points will be combined from golf and fishing to determine the winning team from the front nine and the back nine.

A shootout on Hole 18 will be contested between the top teams to determine the overall tournament winner.

- o The 18th hole will be played as a par 3
- o All 4 golfers will alternate shots until the ball is holed.
- o If there is a tie, the 18th hole will be replayed



Fishing Scoring Metrics		
Species	Points	Notes
Bream Misc. Species	3	Any size
Tilapia	5	Any size
Bass	10	Under 3 lbs.
Bass	10+	Over 3 lbs. plus 2 points for every pound over 3lbs.

On-Course Contests

Ball Drop: \$200 per ball or \$500 for 3 balls. Drop will take place on the 18th fairway following the Tournament. Ball closest to the target wins a framed Masters flag signed by Jack Nicklaus.

Hole in One: Played on holes 2 and 16; Players who score a hole in one will receive a cash prize of \$25,000!

Closets to the Pin: Played on holes 2 and 14; The player closest to the pin wins a \$100 credit to The Bear's Club Pro Shop

Longest Drive: Played on holes 8 and 18; The player with the longest drive wins a \$100 credit to The Bear's Club Pro Shop
